The Candidacy Committee of the CRCNA has notified CEC that Josh completed the learning program so we are able to proceed with a colloquium doctum conversation. Craig led in this conversation. The delegates and Synodical Deputies are able to ask questions.

- 6.1. Jack Van de Hoef, chair of CIC presents background to Kentville CRC, NS requests for CEC to approve the Job Description for Commissioned Pastor.
- 6.1.1. **Motion that CEC approve the job description of Commissioned Pastor for Kentville CRC, for three years beginning on the date of ordination.** **Tabled**
- 6.1.2. **Motion to approve revised Job Description on file.** **Adopted**
- 6.1.2.1. Date of ordination: **Postponed due to CORVID19. TBD.**
- 6.1.3. Synodical deputies concur – CO Art. 23.
- 6.1.4. **Regarding above action in note from CMLT: The Commissioned Pastors handbook states (pg. 30-31): “The Candidacy Committee has suggested that any such arrangement to call a commissioned pastor to a lead position in an organized church be done with an explicit condition that the commissioned pastor make progress toward attaining an M.Div. degree and approval as a candidate for minister of the Word. The condition can be written into the motion of approval relative to the use of Article 23-d [now Article 24-b], with a suitable time line, with expectations of reporting, with expectations of support by the calling church, and with recognition that the approval can be reversed at a given point if the conditions are not met.”)**
7. **Immanuel CRC Council, Cornwall and Pastor Stephen Eckersley** jointly request release under CO Art. 17a. Reports of Regional Pastor, Church Visitor and Joint Agreement on file
- 7.1. **Motion that Immanuel Christian Reformed Church of Cornwall and Pastor Steven Eckersley jointly request to release Pastor Steven Eckersley from active ministerial service in Immanuel CRC as of June 15, 2020 in accordance with Church Order Article 17a. He will lead his final worship service on Sunday, June 14, 2020.**
- Grounds:**
- a. **This is Pastor Steve Eckersley’s request.**
- b. **It is a mutual understanding and agreement between Pastor Steve and the Council of Immanuel CRC that his call to this congregation has come to an end. Council acknowledges that Pastor Steve has served well and has blessed the congregation in his time of service in Immanuel CRC.**
- c. **Pastor Steve would like to take some time to consider his future ministry direction and is not prepared to entertain another call to an established congregation at this time. Stepping out of active ministerial service will provide him time to reflect on his call and future ministry.** **Adopted**
