### **Friday, October 24, 2025 – 9:30 am**

#### **1. Constitution of Classis and Opening Devotions**

1.1. Delegates gather at Barrhaven Fellowship CRC, Ottawa. Host church Pastor Anel leads in time of worship reading Psalm 63:1-8 focusing on the fact we were created for worship; as we do the business of classis may do so with an attitude of worship to our God. Worship softens us that the Holy Spirit can use us for God's glory. We close our worship with song and prayer.

1.2. Classis is declared constituted; delegates from Milford and Fredericton arrive late due to flight delays. Pastor James Kralt [vice] serves as chair for the morning till the chair, Paul Vanderkooy arrives. Pastor Bernie Bakker is stated clerk.

4. The Kanata Community CRC delegates informed classis that because the church is in the process of disaffiliating from the CRCNA they would not be voting on any matters.

    - 5.1.1. **Motion: that CEC approve the work of the stated clerk. Adopted**
6. **Classis Standing Committee** [report on file]
  - 6.1. Classis Interim Committee – Michelle DePooter, vice [report on file]
    - 6.1.1. With sadness the CIC acknowledged on behalf of CEC the disbandment of John Calvin CRC Truro NS.
    - 6.1.2. CIC received notification of transfer of Credentials for Rev. David Kromminga from All Nations CRC to Fredericton CRC; and Rev. Bert Vanderbeek from All Nations CRC to Community CRC, Milford, NS.
    - 6.1.3. CIC processed to transfer of credentials for Pastor Joe Groeneveld from Williamsburg CRC to Classis Quinte – Fellowship CRC, Brighton Ontario.
    - 6.1.4. CIC Approve Gregg Lawson as additional signature for CEC banking as Joe Groeneveld as moved out of the area to Brighton, ON.
    - 6.1.5. **Motion: that CEC approve the work of the CIC. Adopted**
  - 6.2. Personnel Committee – Bernie Bakker [ballot in agenda]
    - 6.2.1. Delegates reviewed the Ballot for vacancies in various CEC positions.
  - 6.3. Classical Ministry Leadership Team – Aaron Thompson [report on file]
    - 6.3.1. Aaron reviews the purpose of CMLT: support students training for ministry in the CRCNA; processing requests for licensure to exhort within CEC; and aiding ministers from other denominations to become ordained pastor in CEC.
    - 6.3.2. **We recommend that the Colloquium Doctum for Rev. Dr. Anel Becker-Ferreira be scheduled for the upcoming classis meeting on October 24-25 at Barrhaven Fellowship CRC.**
    - 6.3.3. **Budget Request for 2026 For the upcoming year we request \$35,000 to cover expenses of supporting three full-time students through seminary. This amount, while higher than our usual request, will help cover most of the costs of student support, while reducing our account balance by a manageable amount.**
    - 6.3.4. **Extend Licensure to Exhort in CEC for Rob MacDonald and David Hanson for two years, October 2027.**
    - 6.3.5. **Motion to approve the work of CMLT. Adopted**
  - 6.4. Classis Youth Ministry Team – Ron Hosmar [report in agenda]

- 6.4.1. Ron shared that youth groups were starting up again; the fall retreat had over 160 youth; a number of youths participated in serve projects in David, Kentucky; Muskegon, Michigan.
- 6.4.2. We say good-bye to Pastor Joe Groenevld who has been a long-time member of the CYMT, but has moved on to Brighton CRC in Classis Quinte. This fall the CYMT will be discussing the make-up of its committee going forward and goals and objectives.
- 6.4.3. Later in the meeting Pastor Dan Hoogland shared a video re the blessing of hosting a SERVE team in Fredericton.
- 6.4.4. If you need to talk to someone about youth or young adult ministry, please contact Pastor Ron Hosmar, "Classis Champion" for youth ministry.

6.5. Ministry to Seafarers, Montreal – Michelle DePooter [report in agenda]

- 6.5.1. Michelle shared several stories re visiting seafarers on the ships. A highlight is the Seafarers Centre for the opportunity to rest, connect with home, or spend time in meditation on God's word.
- 6.5.2. The bike tour was again a success for fellowship and fundraising.
- 6.5.3. Christmas parcels for the seafarers are now being collected.
- 6.5.4. Michelle introduced Brian Vandenberg, treasurer; he shared that Michelle has been served for 25 years at the Center. We give thanks to God for her persistent use of her gifts. She is a blessing to the Seafarers Center. He also shared about changing financial needs and encouraged each congregation to include M2S in their offering schedule each year. Trade is changing across the world and more ships are coming into Montreal.

6.6. Ottawa Campus Ministry – Ryan Farrell, chaplain; Adian Elliot, board chair [reports in agenda]

- 6.6.1. Ryan shared the four key values of Campus Ministry. He continues to meet with students individually and in small groups. The supper discussions are always a highlight – lots of delicious food and challenging conversations. We continue to keep this ministry in our prayers.
- 6.6.2. Adian reported on behalf of the board sharing proposed Bylaw Mission Amendments to strengthening partnerships with other churches and supporters. Several items were discussed. The bylaw amendments were RFI.
- 6.6.3. The board is also looking for more CRC board members.

6.7. Global Coffee Break – Lisa Boonstoppel-Pot

- 6.7.1. Lisa spoke about the expanding ministry of Coffee Break bible study material for women and men, including a vibrant international ministry. She set a display table various Bible Study booklets.

6.8. Diaconal Ministry – Winston Visser

- 6.8.1. Winston shared about the ministry of deacons: by deacons and for deacons. Pastor John Wildeboer is the new director of Diaconal Ministry Canada. Deacons were encouraged to consider being a delegate Synod.
- 6.8.2. Deacons met during lunch in a separate room to share best practises.

11.4. Classis Resonate Mission Team – Sid Ypma; Martin Spoelstra, Resonate

11.4.1. Sid and Martin spoke about the need for mission within CEC. The CRMT lacks team members and lack of passion to reach out beyond our congregations. How is our covenant God leading Classis? There is a distinction between Covenant [personal] and Kingdom calling of mission. How do we move forward in the Kingdom call of proclaiming and living out the good news. We were led through an exercise at our tables of singing [Lord Listen to Your Children Praying] and reflection, sharing and prayer. What do we hear the Spirit saying to us?

11.4.2. The Stated Clerk will send the churches in classis this exercise to do with their leadership.

11.5.1. Two representatives share about the work and encouraged delegates to come and learn about how Mission Montreal can help train congregations in the work of local missions.
