Pre-Meeting Process and Information:

Consider setting a special **Council meeting** prior to Classis to review the agenda for and with the delegates. The agenda, written reports, and video presentations from various ministries are part of this email. Council is encouraged to view and discuss them with the delegates as we will NOT read or view them at the classis meeting.

All delegates/guests are asked to fill in the online [Registration Form](#) so the host church can make arrangements for airport pickup, overnight accommodations, food allergies, etc.

Meeting Focus: You will find many usual agenda items planned for this meeting. Synod 2026 adopted a 10-year Church Planting & Renewal vision, asking every classis to commit to pray for disciples who make disciples, leaders who develop leaders, and churches that participate in God's

mission. A significant portion of the meeting will be hearing about this vision and discerning some early steps for our Classis and Churches.

Internet: Internet access may be intermittent during the Classis meetings. We recommend downloading this Agenda and its supporting documents to your device in advance so you won't need to rely on the church's Internet, if possible.

Attendance: Classis delegates are expected to remain present for the entire session until adjournment. Since session dates are known well in advance, delegates are responsible for clearing their schedules to stay for the full meeting. Maritime delegates have been given permission to leave the meeting earlier due to flight considerations and preparation for the Sabbath. They will continue with the items on the classis agenda as they gather in the airports.

Accommodations: Billeting will be arranged for two nights through the host church. Billeting is encouraged for most attendees due to the early morning start at 8 a.m. both days. Arrival Thursday evening is strongly urged.
